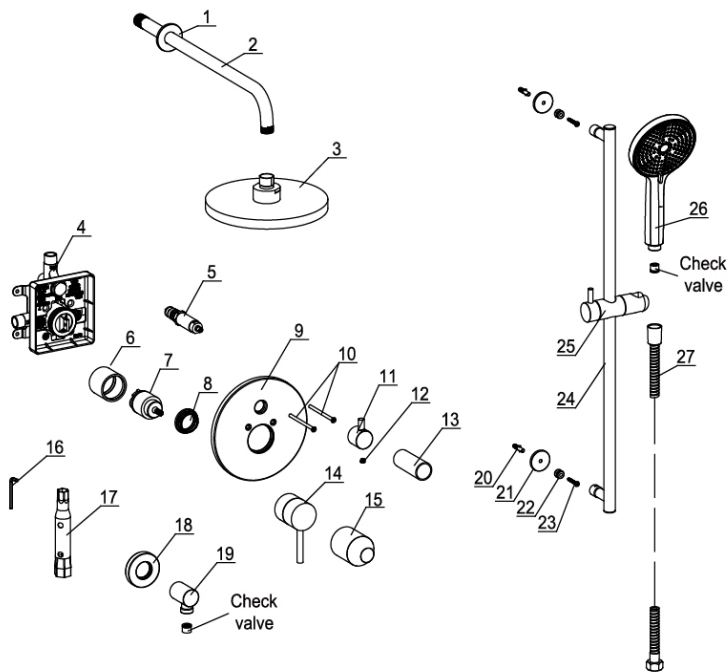
● Handle With Care

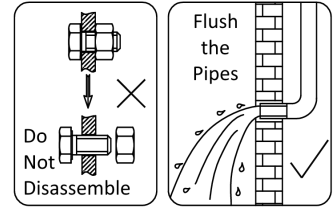

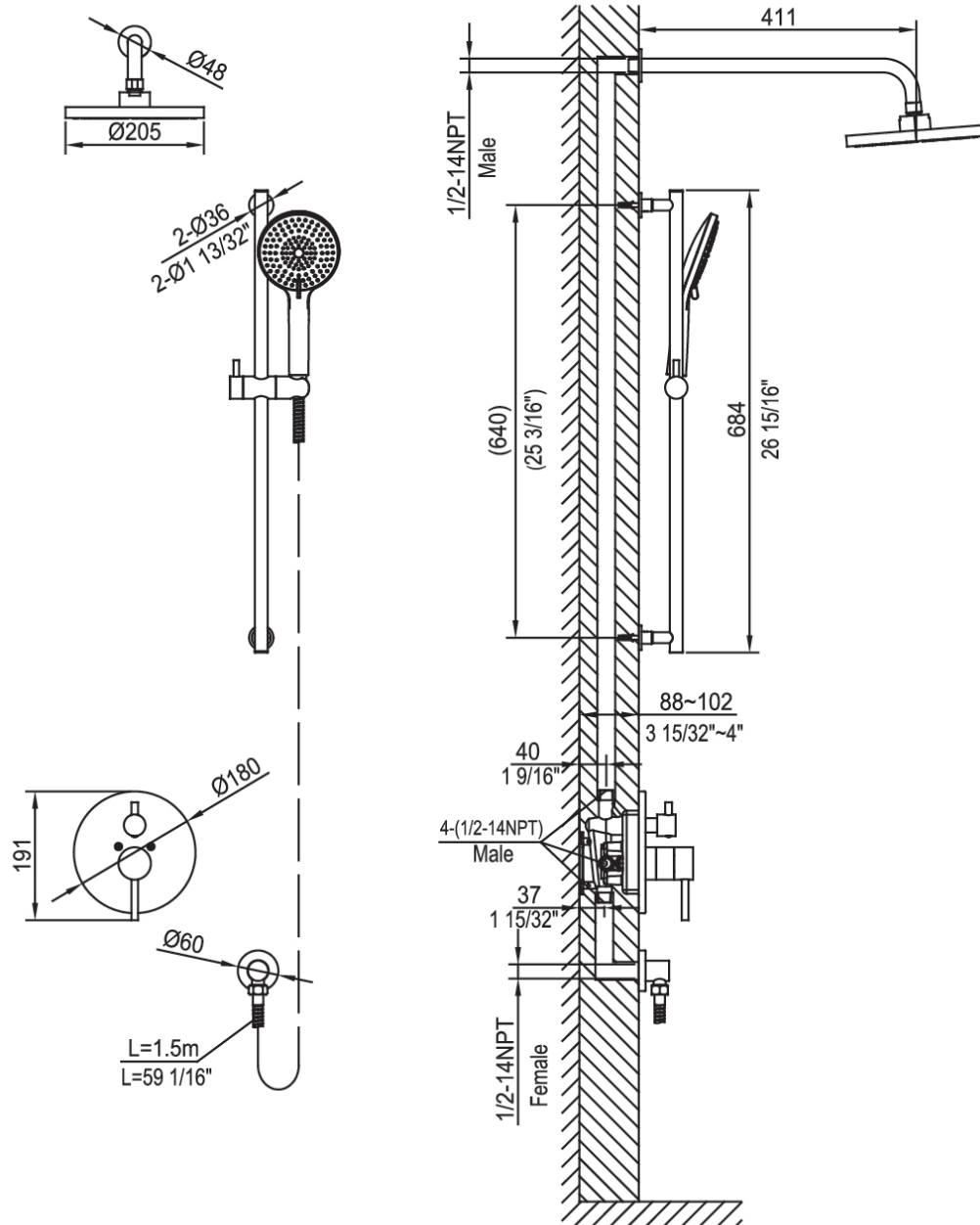
INSTALLATION

IMPORTANT: Recommended for professional installers only. The installer maintains responsibility for installing the product safely.

- * The product is already assembled. Do not disassemble it unless otherwise indicated.
- * Thoroughly clean the inside of all pipes with a cloth before installation.
- * Check all connections for leaks after installation.
- * Water pressure range: 0.05MPa to 1MPa (7.26 psi to 145 psi)
- * Water temperature range: 39°F to 194°F (4°C to 90°C)

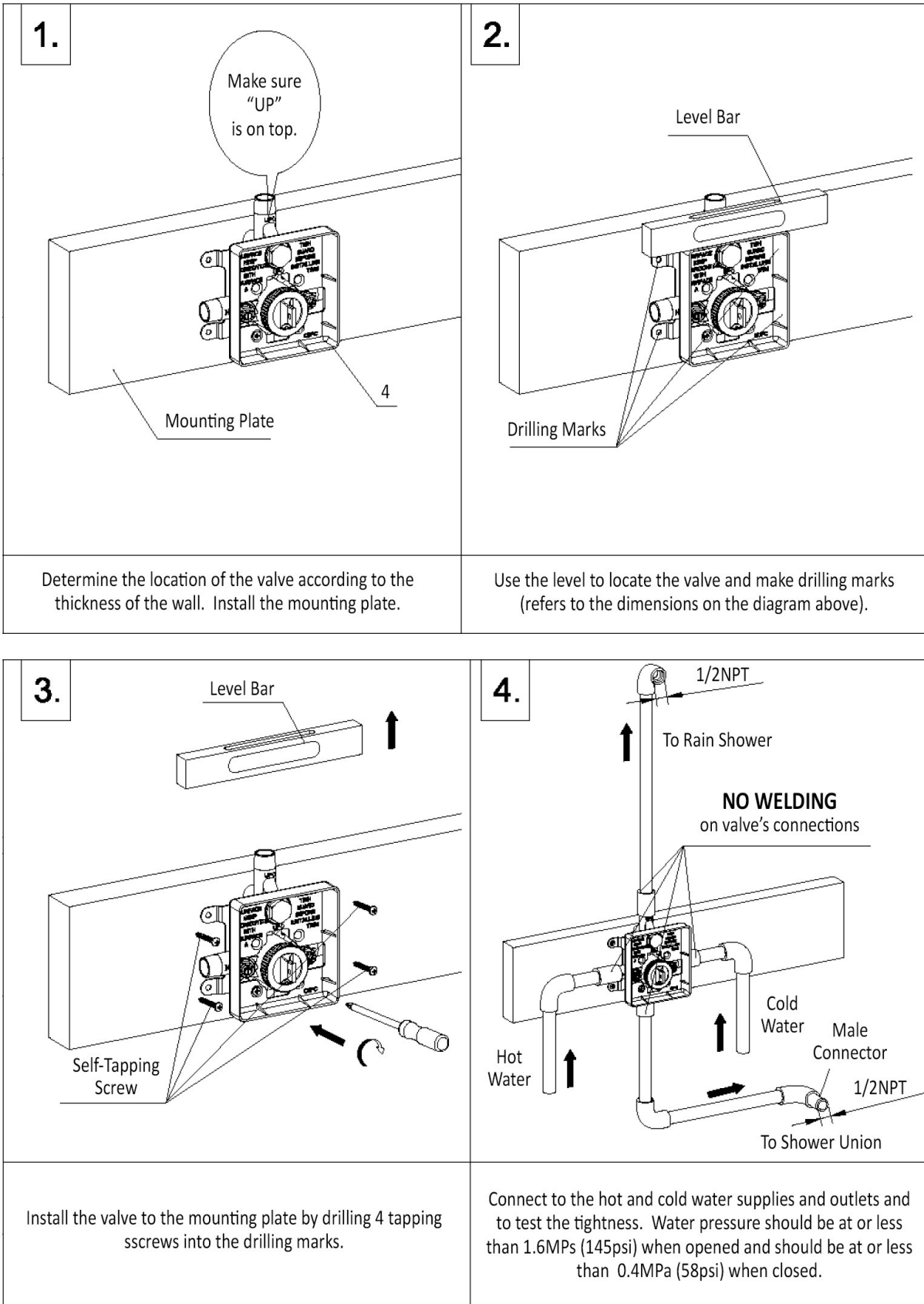

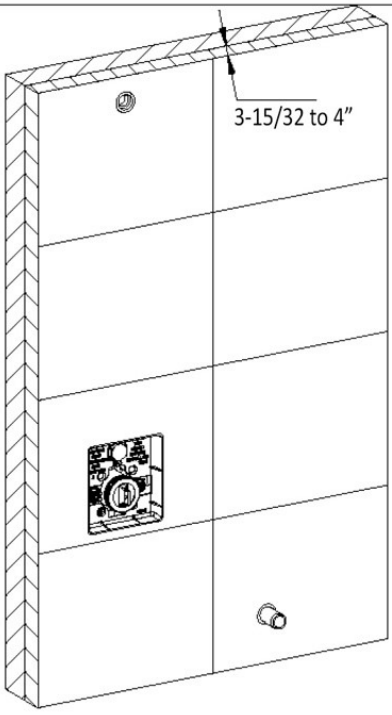
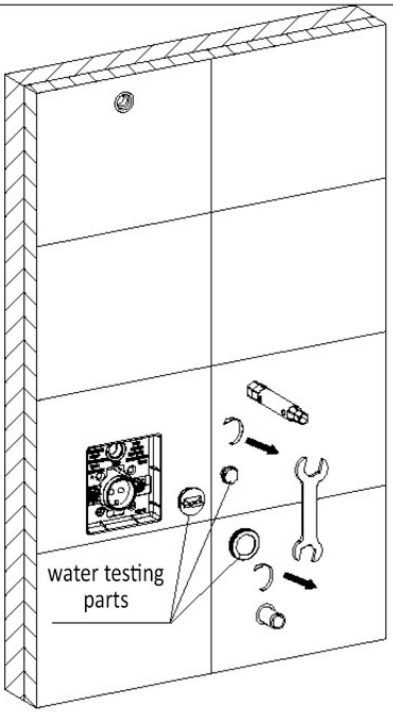
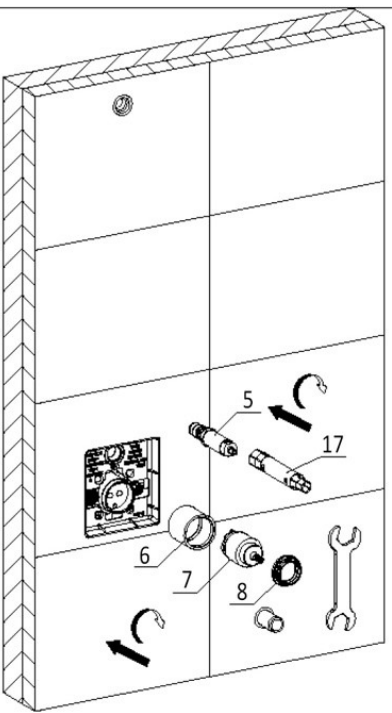
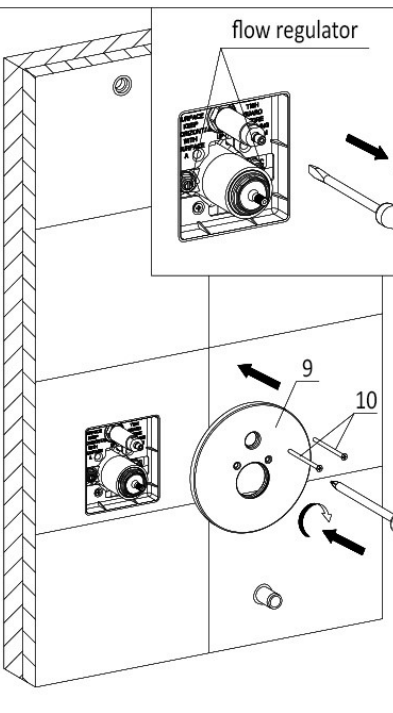
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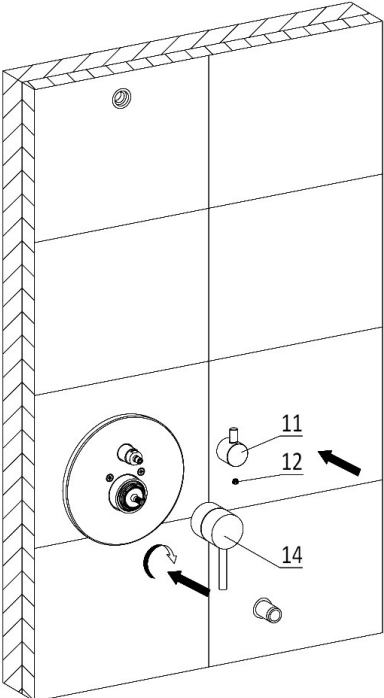
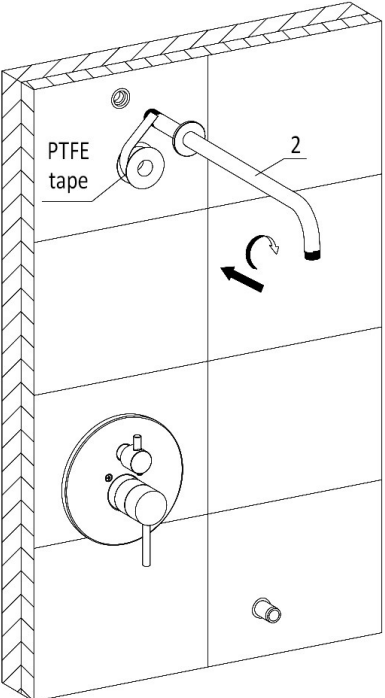
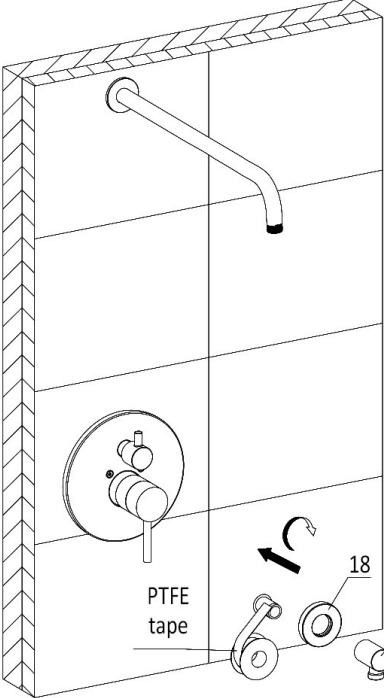
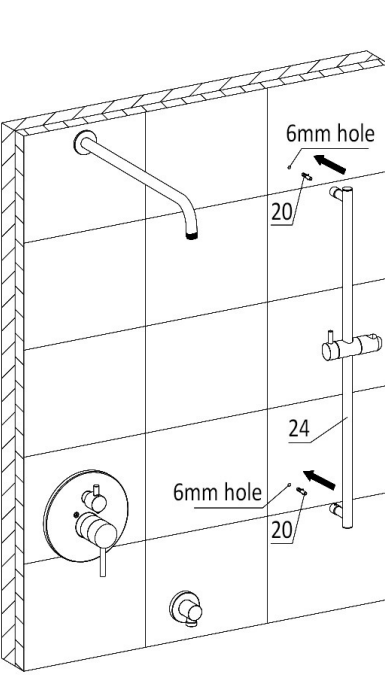
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5.  3-15/32 to 4"	6.  water testing parts
To build a wall as the construction requirement, make sure the thickness of the tilling should be 3-15/32" to 4".	Remove the water testing parts from the valve main body with a wrench and the socket spanner (17) before installation.
7. 	8.  flow regulator
Install the diverter (5), cartridge over (6), switch cartridge (7) and cartridge nut (8) onto the valve main body with the socket spanner (17) and a wrench.	Screw the flow regulator anti-clockwise to increase the water flow, then install the Cover Plate B (9) onto the valve main body with the cross bolts (10).

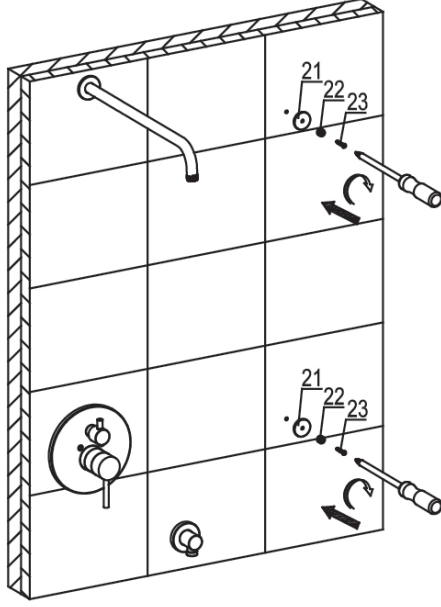
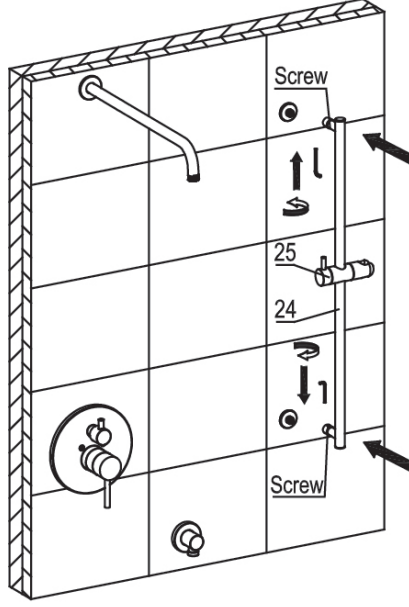
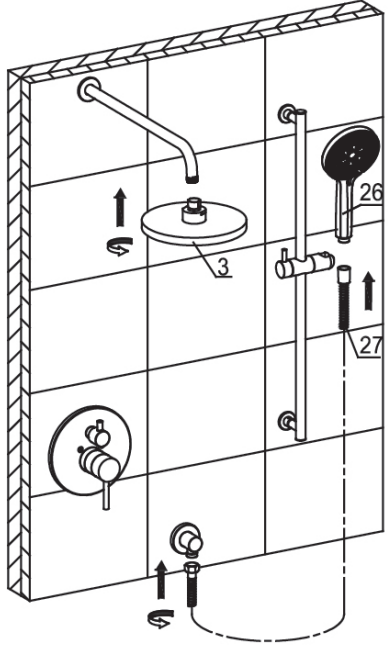
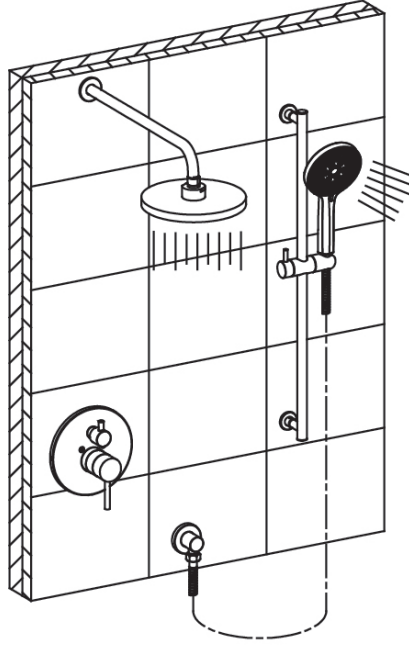

Install the diverter handle (11), decorative plug (12) and switch handle (14) onto the valve main body.	After applying sealing tape onto the thread of the shower arm (2), screw the shower arm into the female connector and adjust its direction.
11. 	12. 
After applying sealing tape onto the male connector, install the Cover Plate C (18) and Shower Union (19) into the male connector, and adjust its direction.	Dig two holes according to the length of the sliding rail (24), with diameter at 6mm, and knock explosive plugs (20) into the holes.

INSTALLATION

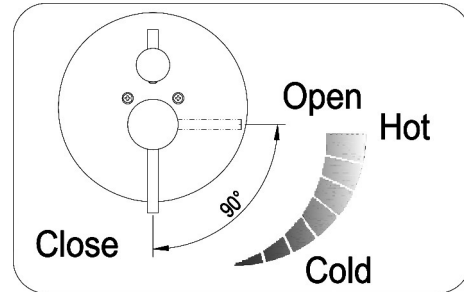
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13.  Diagram 13 shows a wall-mounted shower panel with a grid pattern. A decorative plate (21) is being attached to the wall using self-tapping screws (23). A Phillips screwdriver is shown driving a screw into the wall. The plate has a curved shower arm (12) attached to it. The panel also has a circular shower head (26) and a flexible hose (27) attached to it.	14.  Diagram 14 shows the sliding rail (24) being inserted into the fixing seats (25) of the shower panel. The rail has a shower hook (25) attached to it. The rail is being secured to the wall using screws (16) and an Allen wrench (16). The panel also has a circular shower head (26) and a flexible hose (27) attached to it.
13. fix the decorative plate C(21) and fixing seats(12) at the wall with the self-tapping screws(23) with a Phillips screwdriver.	14. Put the sliding rail(24) with shower hook(25) into the fixing seats, tighten the screws of the sliding rail with Allen wrench (16) to fix the sliding rail(24).
15.  Diagram 15 shows the rain shower (3) being attached to the shower arm (12). The handshower (26) and shower union (27) are also being connected to the flexible hose (27). The panel also has a circular shower head (26) and a flexible hose (27) attached to it.	16.  Diagram 16 shows the final step of the installation, where the water is turned on to test the tightness of all joints. The panel also has a circular shower head (26) and a flexible hose (27) attached to it.
15. Screw the rain shower(3) at the shower arm, and connect the handshower(26) and shower union with the flexible hose(27).	16. Finally, turn on the water to test tightness of all joints to finish installation.

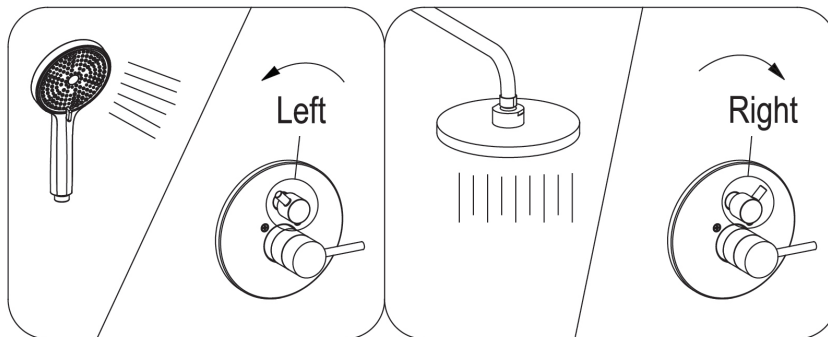
USAGE

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- ◇ Turn the diverter handle counter-clockwise to turn on and increase hot water flow to higher water temperature.
- ◇ Operate reversely to turn off and decrease the water temperature from hot to cold.



- ◇ Turn the diverter handle to the left, water comes out from handshower.
- ◇ Turn the diverter handle to the right, water comes out from rainhead.



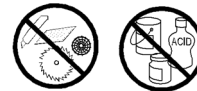

4. Do not allow any cleaning product to remain on your shower set for longer than necessary.
5. Do not use any abrasive cleaning products, such as scrubbing detergent, polisher, sand-cloth, paper tissue, or scrapper.
6. Do not use detergents or soaps that contain acid or that are undissolvable.
7. After cleaning, rinse thoroughly with clean water to remove any cleaner residue.



WARRANTY

Limited Lifetime Warranty
